

The Isle of Mull, 'Eagle Island' as it has been dubbed, has a lot to offer the keen bird watcher and naturalist. There are breeding Golden Eagles and Sea Eagles plus many other raptors including Hen Harrier, Peregrine and Merlin and Short eared owls and Barn owls. Great northern divers and Red and Black throated divers and in winter, Slavonian grebe inhabit our sea lochs with a high density of waders and ducks. If you have a sharp eye you can find otter on the shores of most sea lochs. Alan is the local recorder and will be pleased to share with you and point out the best areas for seeing particular species of birds.

For those interested in flora there are many different Orchids to be found in June and July. A visit to the historic island of Iona is well worth a visit in May and June to find breeding Corncrake and to enjoy the Abbey and some wonderful beaches.
